

## Eligibility & Admission Procedure of BPO Course

**ACADEMIC QUALIFICATION:** +2 with English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Botany & Zoology or Mathematics (PCB/PCBZ or PCM) with minimum of 40% marks in each subject for all categories.

The Candidates who have appeared in the qualifying examination with PCB/PCBZ/PCM subjects OR awaiting results of +2 can also apply.

**METHOD OF SELECTION:** Selection is based on Merit. Shortlisted candidates undergo a preliminary written test and interview at the time of counseling.

**SCHOLARSHIP:** To the Eligible SC/ST, OBC, PwD students, by processing the UGC/ affiliating university scholarship in respect of SC/ST, OBC, PwD students each year as per applicable norms.

**HOSTEL:** The Institute provides hostel facility for outside Chennai Students only.

*They work in a challenging and rewarding profession where they see patients on a daily basis and usually over a long term. The four-year degree course qualifies you as a professional Prosthetist/Orthotist. This is a dual qualification as a healthcare professional.*

## Teaching Methodology at IIPO

At IIPO, we endeavour to achieve evidence based teaching and continuously modify the methodology based on feedback from students. Teaching is delivered by a variety of methods and varies between subjects. It includes a combination of lectures, supported by supervised tutorials and practical laboratory sessions. The high clinical content of the course is mainly taught through experiential learning. Students work as part of small teams with real patients to assess, fabricate and fit prosthetic/orthotic devices.



Assessment is based on written exam and coursework. Clinical work-based learning is assessed in a clinical setting. The range of assessments includes essays, written exams, practical exams, problem-solving, multiple choice questions, oral presentations and project work. The final clinical examinations are oral exams held after each clinical placement period. Projects are presented as part of a final run down to graduation
